THE HUNTER VALLEY

Australia's oldest wine-growing region, the **Hunter Valley**, is also renowned for its fine dining, cooking schools, galleries, health spa retreats and golf courses. A diverse calendar of food and wine events including performances by world famous names in jazz, opera and blues music also take place throughout the year.

- » Local produce includes cheese, chocolate, oils, olives and more
- » Overnight at Audrey Wilkinson's Guesthouse with a gourmet dinner prepared by a private chef
- » Experience fine dining at Bistro Molines, The Tallavera Grove Vineyard

- » Time visit with an event such as **F.O.O.D.** in April and **Orange Wine Week** in October

SYDNEY FISH MARKETS

Sydney Fish Markets are the largest of their kind in the Southern Hemisphere providing the perfect opportunity to sample fresh Australian seafood. One of Sydney's most popular attractions, attracting locals, food fanatics and tourists alike.

SPOTLIGHT:

- » Located just behind Sydney's iconic Darling Harbour
- » Open daily from 7am-4 pm (except Christmas Day)
- » **Behind the scenes tour** held every weekday except Tuesday 06:40am-08:30am, includes a visit to the live auction floor and viewing of over 100 species of seafood.
- » **Sydney Seafood School**, offers a range of cooking classes delivered by some of Australia's finest chefs
- » Dine at on-site restaurants or pick up supplies from one of the retailers



EMIRATES ONE&ONLY WOLGAN VALLEY, GREATER BLUE MOUNTAINS



Set on a 1,618 hectare property, surrounded by towering sandstone escarpments and home to grazing wombats, wallabies and wallaroos, this former cattle station in the greater Blue Mountains, is considered one of the state's finest luxury food destinations.

- » The resorts culinary mantra is 'seasonal, regional and organic' drawing upon the finest ingredients from the area's artisan producers as well as the resorts own kitchen garden
- » Add on a food and wine tour, exploring the local wine regions of Mudgee or Orange
